Two of our students, Lola and Archie, have epilepsy, and we feel it is important to raise awareness and help others understand what living with epilepsy can be like for a child and their family and to show them our support in their journeys.

No child should live in fear of their own body. Seizures can be frightening and may leave children feeling confused, in pain, and alone. In the UK, nearly every hour another child or young person is diagnosed with epilepsy.

EASTER SERVICE AT CHURCH


