- Black shorts or knee-length cycling shorts

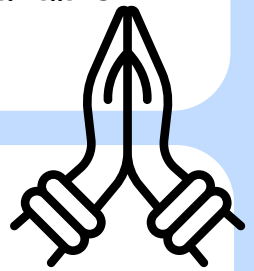
